The Imperial Court of All Oklahoma Inc. (ICAO) is a 501c3 non-profit charitable fundraising organization operating in the State of Oklahoma, for the people of Oklahoma. The efforts and support is comprised of 100% volunteers.

In 2007, the ICAO was Co-founded by Christian La Fleur Dior D' and Kris Kohl. Our goal is to unite community based organizations and the people of the community through love, understanding, education, service and fraternity.

The mission of The Imperial Court of All Oklahoma, Inc. shall be to provide educational, public service, and entertainment events that unify all aspects of community to benefit those in need. To that end the ICAO embraces people of all genders, ages, lifestyles, sexual orientation, and ethnicities. As an organization, the ICAO strives to build bridges between organizations/businesses and individuals and to bring together the Gay, Lesbian, Transgender, Bisexual, and Heterosexual communities in a common purpose - to improve life for the people of Oklahoma.

A main goal of The Imperial Court of All Oklahoma is to unite the Oklahoma LGBT and Allied Community as one entity, for the purpose of helping fill the need for funding for Charity organizations within the State of Oklahoma. These include those who are affected by HIV/AIDS, health care, pet care, breast cancer, youth services, victims of domestic violence and disasters – personal or natural...just to name a few. The ICAO is willing to assist any non-profit organization that demonstrates the need for assistance in charitable fundraising.

The ICAO is a part of a much larger organization called the International Court System (ICS). The ICAO is the Oklahoma Chapter representing the entire state of Oklahoma. The ICS has chapters in many cities in the United States, Canada and Mexico.

In 1965, Jose Sarria proclaimed herself the Empress of San Francisco, and laid the foundation for the formation of the Imperial Court de San Francisco. Today, the International Court System (ICS) has over 70 Chapters in the United States, Canada and Mexico. That makes, the ICS, the second largest GLBT organization in the world. On June 5th, 2010 The International Court System will celebrate its 45 Anniversary with a gala state dinner in Lexington, KY.

In the mid 1990's, Empress Jose named Empress Nicole the Great to be her Heir Apparent, and formed the International Court Council (ICC). After many previous attempts to establish a cohesive international organization, the ICC finally took hold and is now on its second decade of service to its member chapters. The Member Courts are organizations bound together in shared structure, policies and goals.

The Court has played a significant role in many local LGBT communities spearheading AIDS fundraising, human rights advocacy, and for many the link to the LGBT community. The mission of the ICC is to preserve the legacy of the International Court System, promote cooperation and communication among member courts, create awareness and visibility, and stake our place in GLBT history.

In February 2007, Empress Nicole the Great was elevated as the head of the ICS and named Queen Mother of the Americas. She ushered in the Renaissance Era, and expanded the Council to create a more diverse organization. She also formed a Parliament to provide representation for each Member Courts. In 2004, the International Court conference was organized, and plans are underway for the first Transgender Conference; also there is an annual Women's Court Conference held every year. The ICC has also signed partnership accords with Eagle Canada, The Matthew Shepard Foundation, National Gay & Lesbian Task Force (NGLTF) and the International Gay Rodeo Association.

The International Court Council provides many services including a comprehensive website, a quarterly online newsletter "Communique", and presents the prestigious "Jose Honors" to recognize court members for outstanding service. The ICC took leadership role on international GLBT issues such as "Get Out The Vote" voter registration campaign in 2008; took a strong stand on the repeal of the ban on entry to the U.S. of persons living with HIV/AIDS; endorse making Harvey Milk's birthday a state holiday in California; supported the Employment Non-Discrimination ACT (ENDA). In 2006, The ICC played a role in the successful campaign when the city of San Francisco named a portion of 16th Street in the Castro as "Jose Sarria Court", with a permanent plaque funded by the ICC. In 2009, the ICC presented "Stonewall 40 - Trans Heroes 40," in commemoration of the 40th Anniversary of Stonewall, honoring forty transgender individuals and presented a commemorative plaque to the historic Stonewall Inn in New York City. The ICS was one of the first organizations to endorse the 2009 March on Washington, and thanks to the Imperial Court of New York, hosted a major event in Washington DC. Currently the ICS is taking a leadership role in the Harvey Milk National Stamp Campaign, to have a US commemorative stamp to honor a true American champion of human rights.

The International Court Council is also proud of its many international fundraising campaigns. In 1994, many Member Courts collectively raised over \$14,000.00 for the Tijuana AIDS Project, a tradition that continues annually. The ICS has also raised tens of thousands of dollars for Women's Breast Cancer Campaign; became a major sponsor of NGLTF's Creating Change conference raising over \$15,000.00 in the past two years. But perhaps the single crowning achievement of the ICS was the coming together of courts in the United States and Canada in 2009 to raise over \$100,000.00 for the Matthew Shepard Foundation and like organization in Canada.

After fifty years of noble deeds, the International Court System has reasons to feel proud. Today the ICS remains a strong, viable and important member of the LGBT communities. For beyond the glitters of the crown and grand titles, the ICS has made a difference in many people's lives and earned a place in GLBT history.

The charitable efforts of the ICAO have funded many organizations throughout the community locally and nationally.

During the Fiscal Year of Reign VII of the Imperial Court of All Oklahoma there were a total of thirty two (14) fundraising events hosted.
